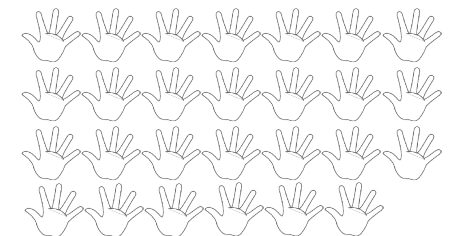
When aged 16 - 18 years old, 4 would be NEETs (not in education, employment or training)



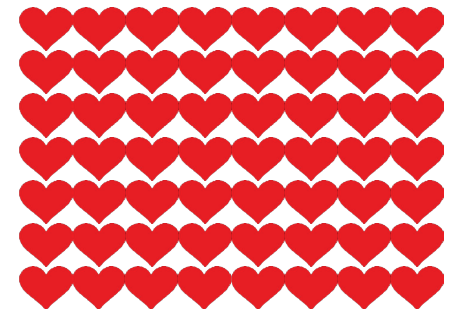

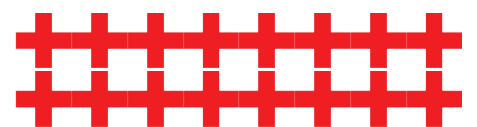
