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Kent Police are requesting a review of this premises licence under the licensing objectives of prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm at KINGS HEAD, MAIDSTONE, KENT, ME17 2AN. Ms Beverley SIMPSON-SWEET is the designated premises supervisor and premises licence holder along with Mr Kenneth SWEET. The premises trades as a pub. There is a premises licence which permits the sale of alcohol between 10:00 to 00:30 Monday to Saturday.

On Wednesday 8th February 2023 a Kent Police executed a search warrant at the premises acting on intelligence received. This was in relation to a male linked to the premises being involved in the dealing of drugs and possession of firearms. During the execution of the warrant a search of the premises was conducted and as a result of this search drugs were located in the upstairs rooms, in the form of small bags of cannabis and bags of white powder, these items are believed to be connected with the supply of drugs. Also found upstairs was a quantity of Section 1 firearms ammunition. A search of the bar area located two imitation firearms, a BB gun and a starter revolver, and an ASP baton under the bar and another BB gun secreted between the bar and kitchen area in an easily accessible location. Four shotguns were also found at the premises, these were legally held under a shotgun licence however three were correctly stored within a secure gun safe but the fourth was found standing at the top of the stairs.

The male subject of the intelligence of the premises licence holder and lives on the premises and a quantity of the drugs were located in a bag belonging to the designated premises supervisor/premises licence holder. Vehicles at the location were also searched where further weapons were located.

It is the belief of Kent Police that this premises, if allowed to continue to operate unchecked, represents a serious and real danger to the safety of the public. It is clear from the location where items were seized from that the premises licence holders were aware of them and permitted them to remain on site. The presence of multiple weapons within the public areas gives rise to concerns with regards to the intended use or need for these items and believe it is indicative of an involvement of those present in serious crime.

Due to the serious nature of weapons being in the bar gives Kent Police concern in the management's ability in running a safe pub. Kent Police has no faith that Ms SIMPSON-SWEET or family members are able to uphold the licensing objectives for Public Safety and Crime and Disorder.

At approximately 0800 hours on Wednesday 8th February 2023 whilst on uniform duty with PS MILLINS, PC's LAWLESS, DERRY, AUSTIN & MUIR we attended The Kings Head public house, Headcorn Road, Grafty Green after acting upon information received from a section 23 misuse of drugs act search warrant. The property is a largedetached premises. At which we were joined by a second Police search team. At the rear of the property PC AUSTIN and LAWLESS knocked the door repeatedly and shouted 'Police'. In response a female's face appeared (later identified herself as Mrs SWEET) at the window over the front door looking directly at us. She then moved away from the window and several minutes went by without any obvious effort to open the door by the occupant. PC LAWLESS and AUSTIN then made preparation to force open the backdoor which they paused as Mrs SWEET then appeared at the backdoor and unlocked it. On entering the property, I moved up the staircase to the top floor where I located a bedroom off to the left within which I found a male who later confirmed his identity as Ken SWEET. I requested SWEET show me the location of the gun cabinet licensed to the address and occupant. This was located in the loft space, SWEET

unlocked the cabinet which was secured to a roof beam. Inside the cabinet were three shotguns which I seized as AJB1-self-loading shotgun, AJB/2-shotgun over/under, AJB/4-shotgun side by side. When asked where the fourth shotgun was located SWEET led me to the landing where a small single shot shotgun was leaning against the wall, I seized it and exhibit as AJB/3. SWEET was then accompanied to the ground floor where the other occupants of the property were sat near the bar area. Myself and PC DERRY initiated the search of the ground floor bar area where I located a black BB handgun under the bar which I seized as AJB/5. Also behind the bar I located and seized a Police ASP baton as AJB/6 and a small black pistol as AJB/7. On the shelf beside these under the bar I located and seized a small clear plastic snap lock bag containing a brown solid substance I believe to be cannabis resin (solid) from within a red purse as AJB/8. I further seized Ken SWEETS firearm certificate as AJB/9. All officers left the address at 12:05 hours that same day. My body worn video footage of our approach and entry to the property I exhibit as AJB/10.






