## **INSTALLING RENEWABLE ENERGY TECHNOLOGY**

# **Issue for Decision**

To consider a range of recommendations designed to reduce carbon emissions and generate savings through the use of photovoltaic technology.

### **Decision Made**

- 1) That the purchase, installation and operation of photovoltaic technology be approved on the following buildings with the Council's estate:-
  - (a) Lockmeadow Market Hall 50kw Array
  - (b) Vinters Park Crematorium 10kw and 4kw Array
  - (c) Magnolia House 24kw Array
- 2) That the purchase of renewably generated electricity from a third party at Maidstone House be approved;
- That a budget of £125,000 to implement the recommendations be approved;
- 4) That delegated authority be given to the Commercial Projects Manager to spend the budget and enter into the appropriate contracts to implement the recommendations;
- That delegated authority be given to the Commercial Projects
  Manager to obtain the necessary permissions and licences to
  implement the recommendations including the registration for Feed
  in Tariff; sale, export or purchase of electricity; and appropriate
  agreements with the District Network Operator; and to assign those
  permissions and licences as appropriate; and
- 6) That the progression of the work towards entering into an assignable power purchase agreement with a generator of renewable energy be approved and the trial for Maidstone House and the Gateway be agreed.
